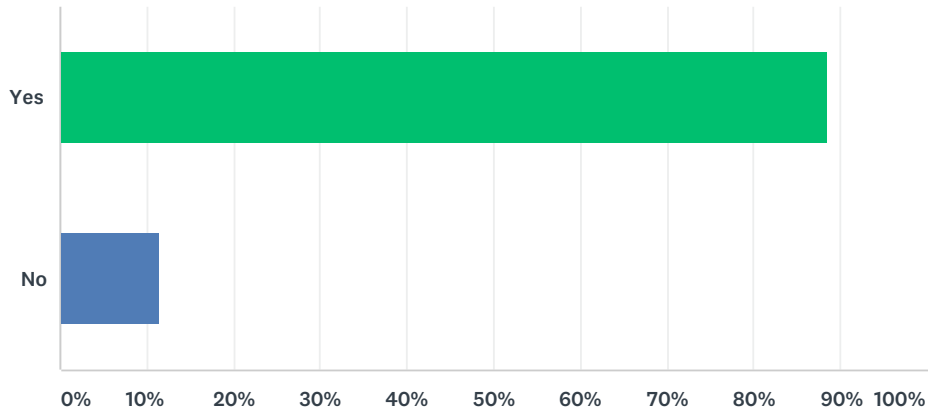


CLASS OF 2021, WHAT MAKES YOU TICK? SURVEY RESULTS

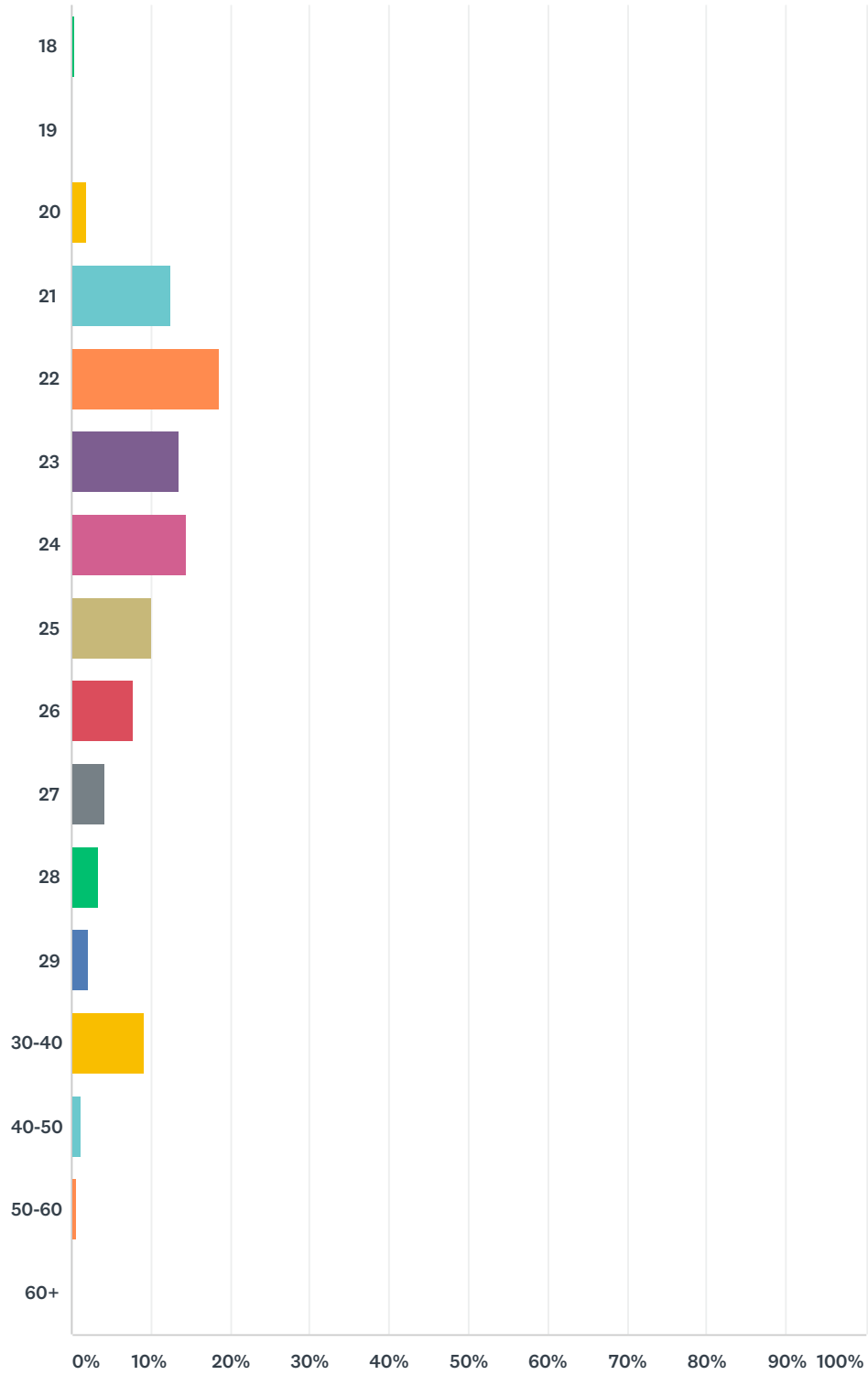

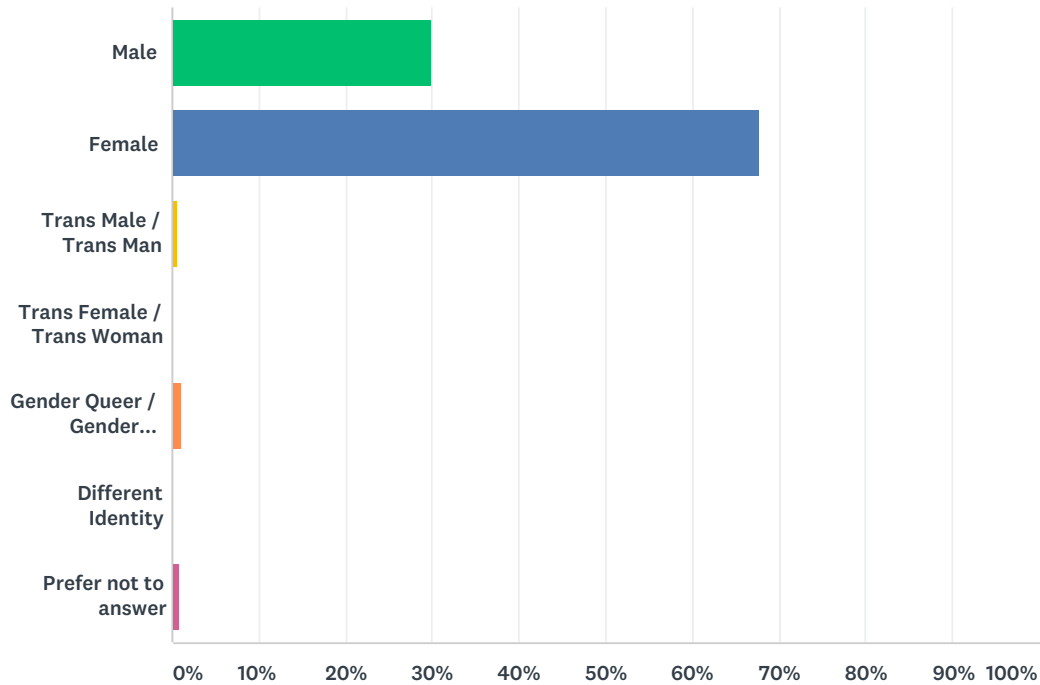

Q3 Which of the following best describes your gender?

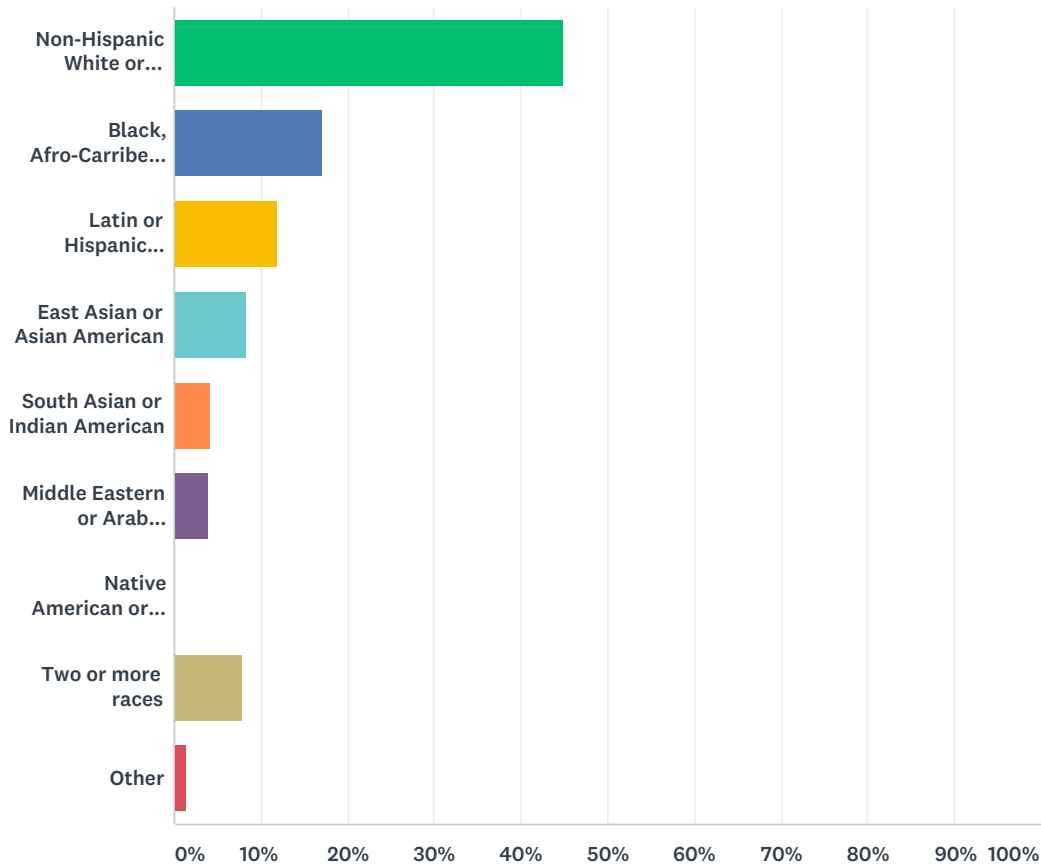

Q4 Which of the following best represents your racial or ethnic heritage?

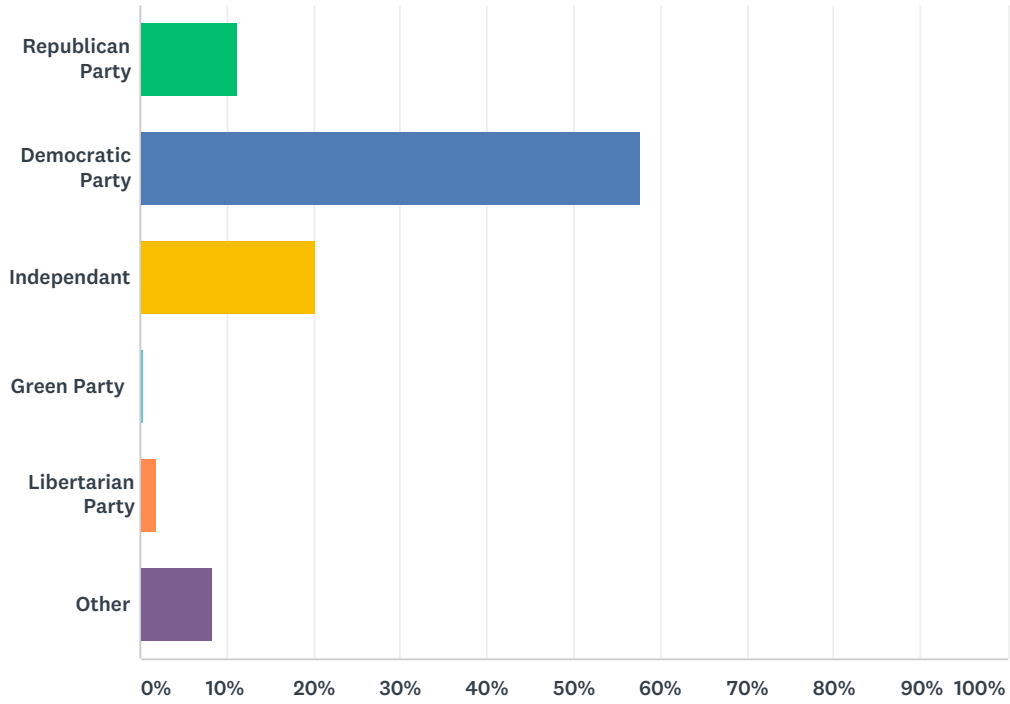

Q5 What best describes your political affiliation?

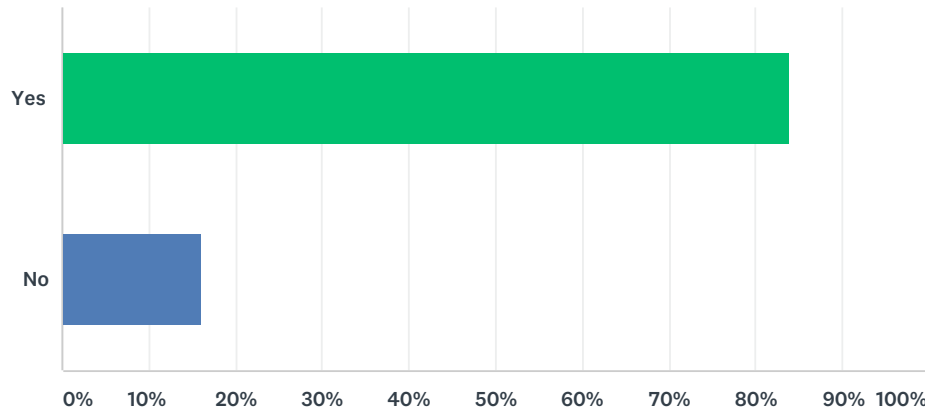

Q6 Did you vote in the last U.S. presidential election (in 2016)?

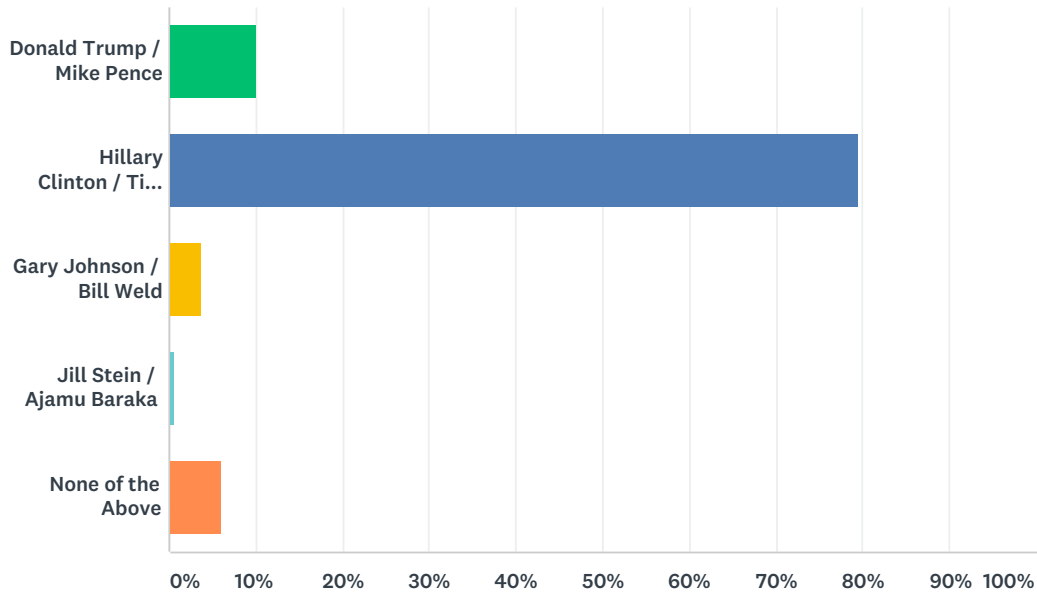

Q7 Who did you vote for?

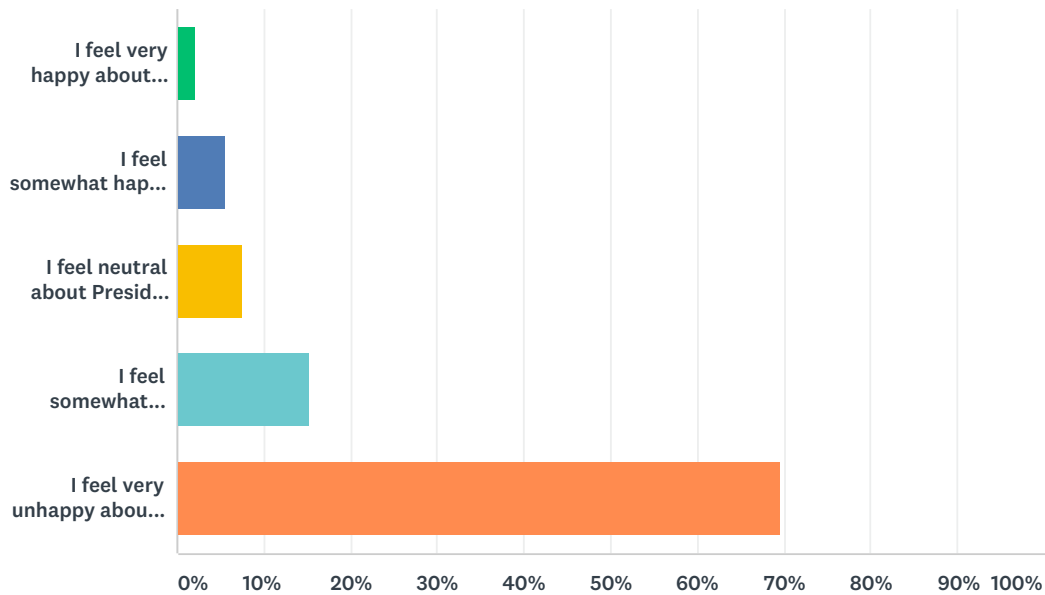

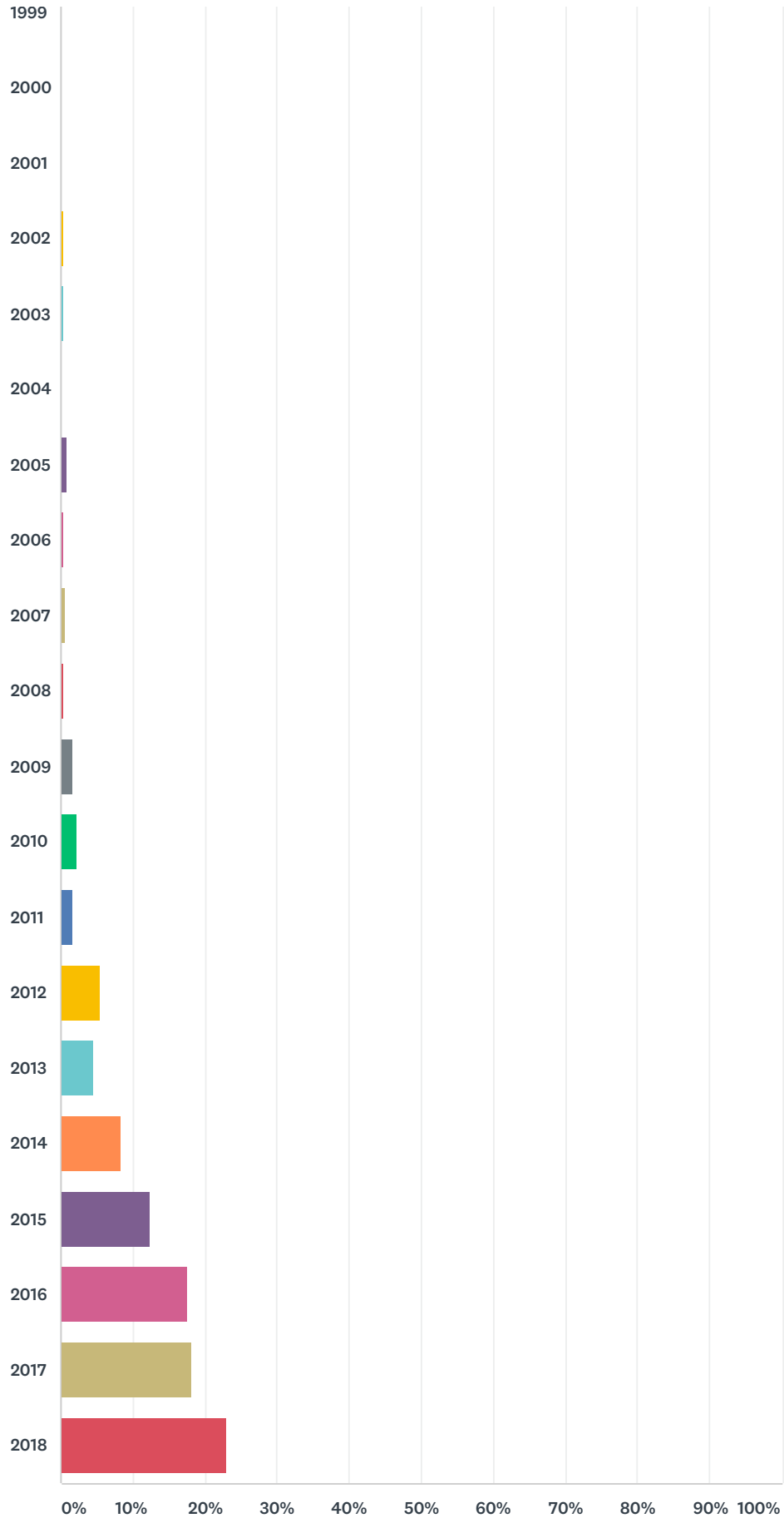

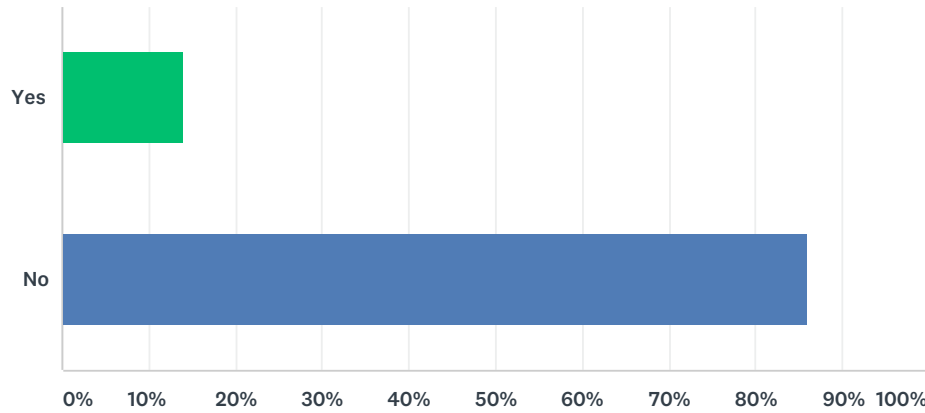

Q10 Did you attend graduate school and receive a Masters or PhD before applying to law school?

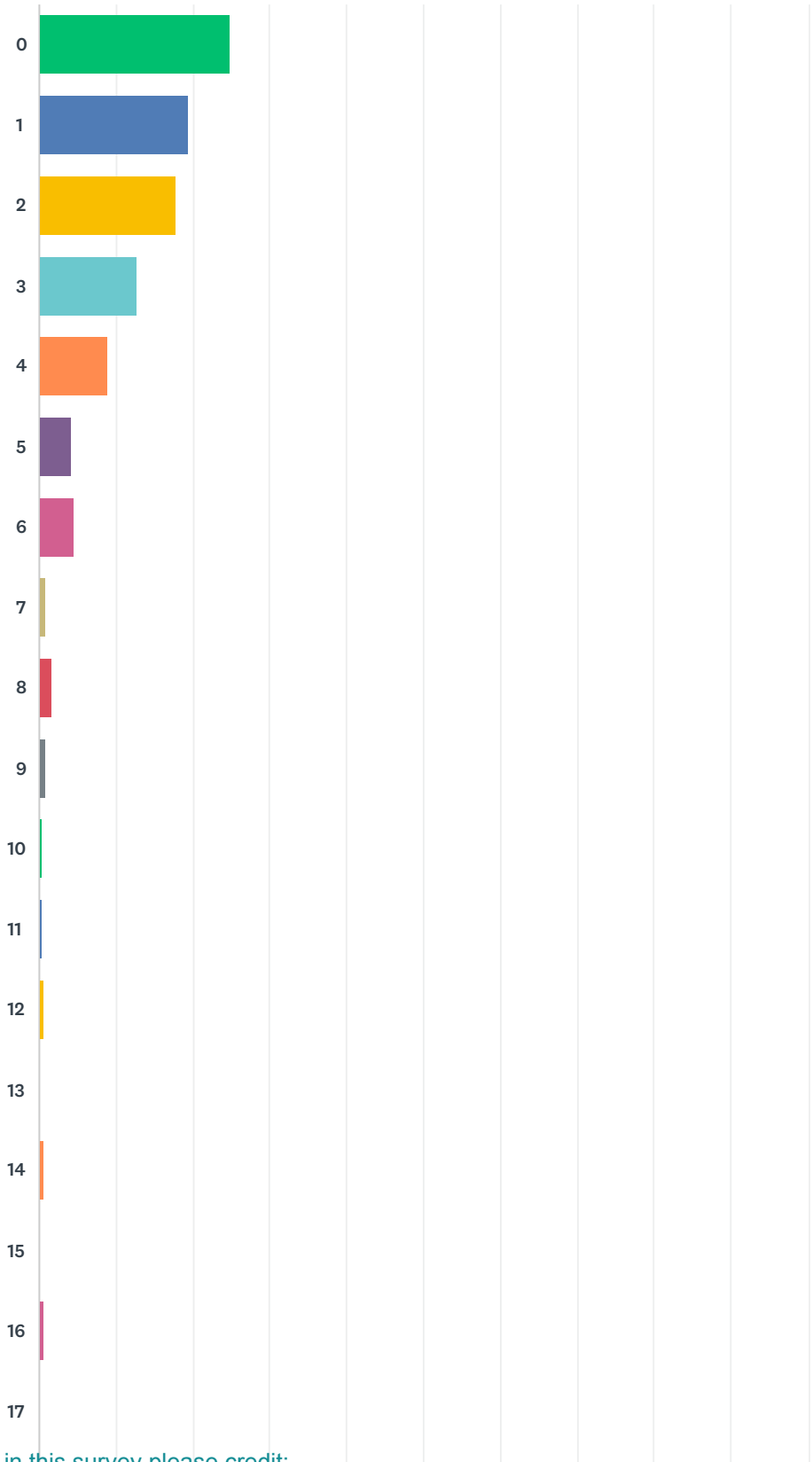

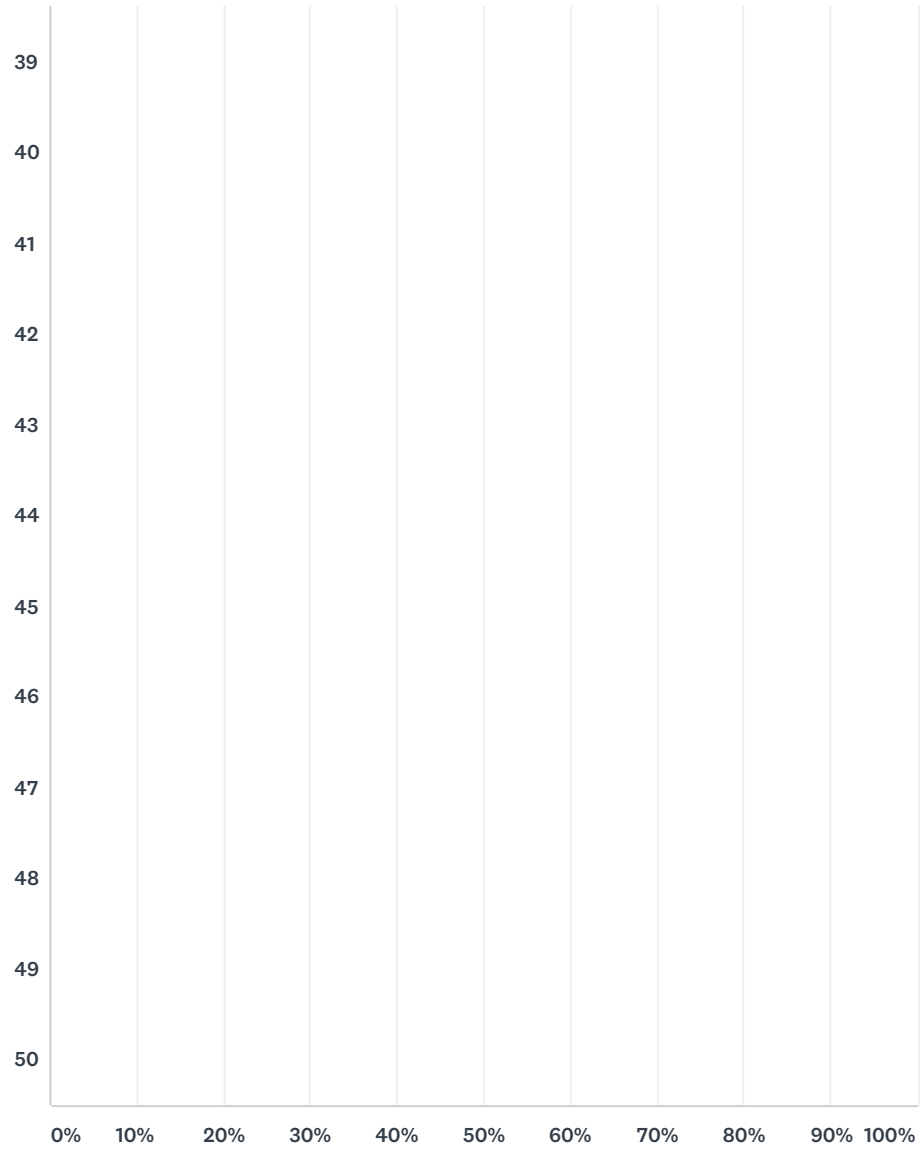

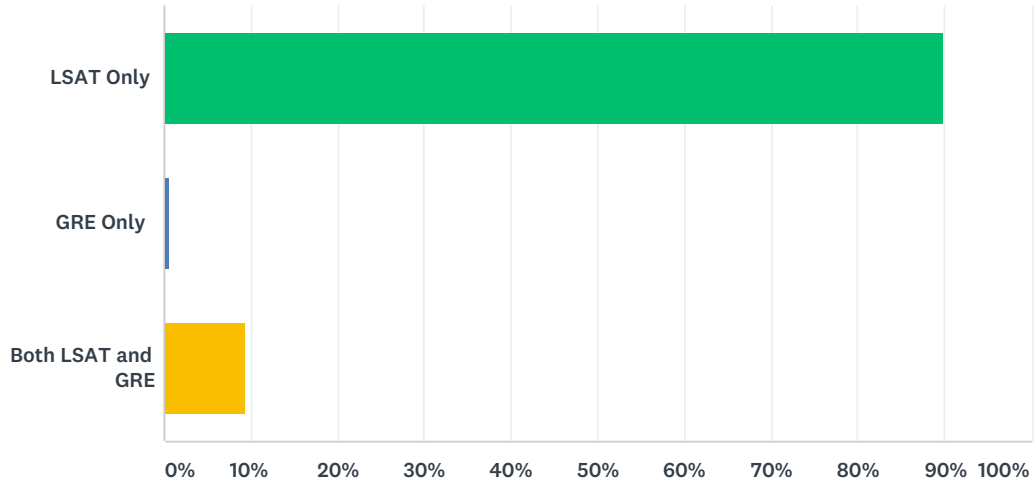

Q12 Did you take the LSAT or GRE?

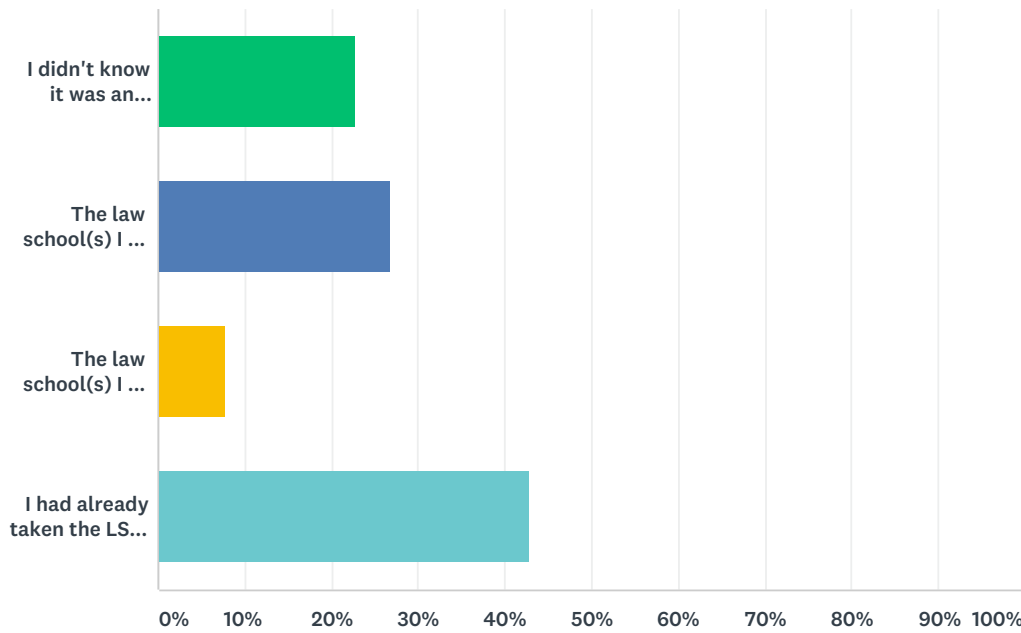

Q13 Which of the following reasons best describes why you did NOT consider taking the GRE when applying to law school?

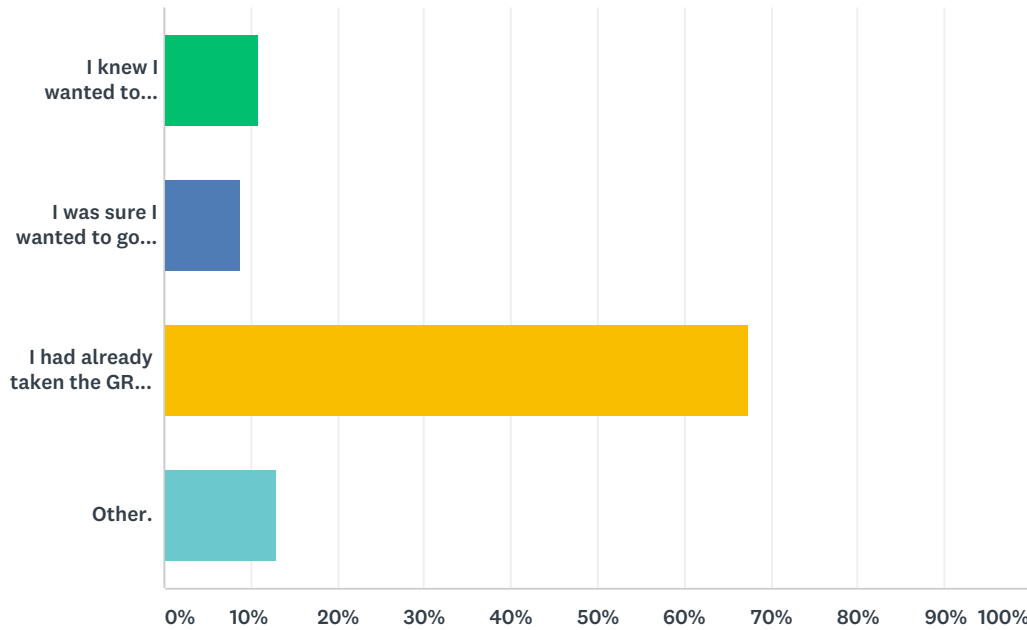

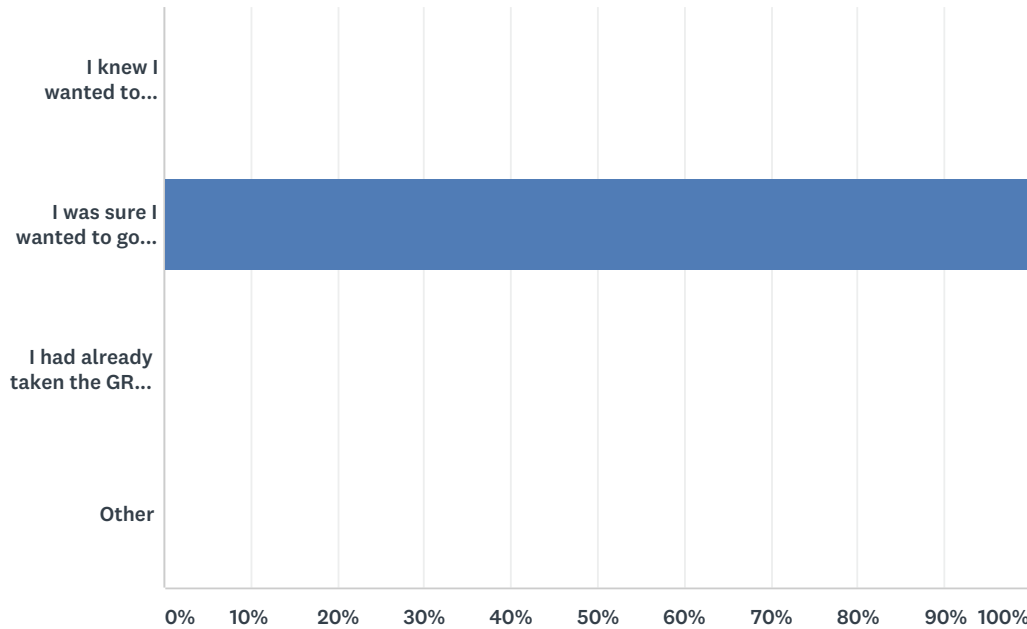

Q15 Which of the following best describes why you took only the GRE prior to applying to law school?

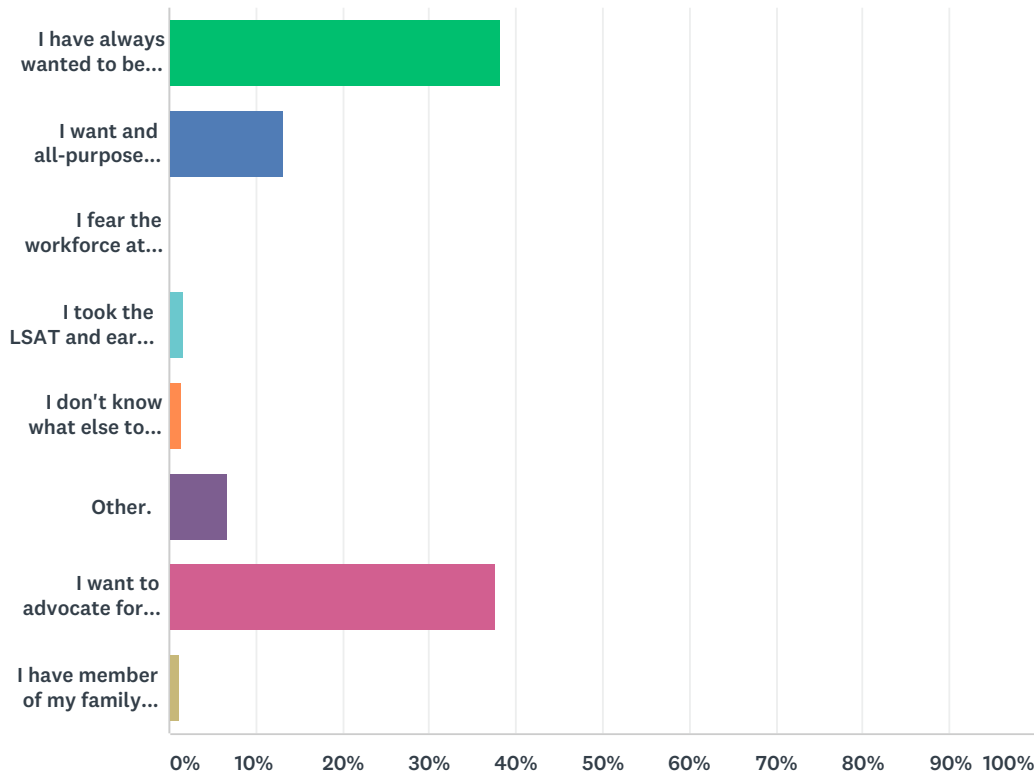

Q16 Which of the following reasons best represents your PRIMARY reason for applying to law school during the most recent admissions cycle?

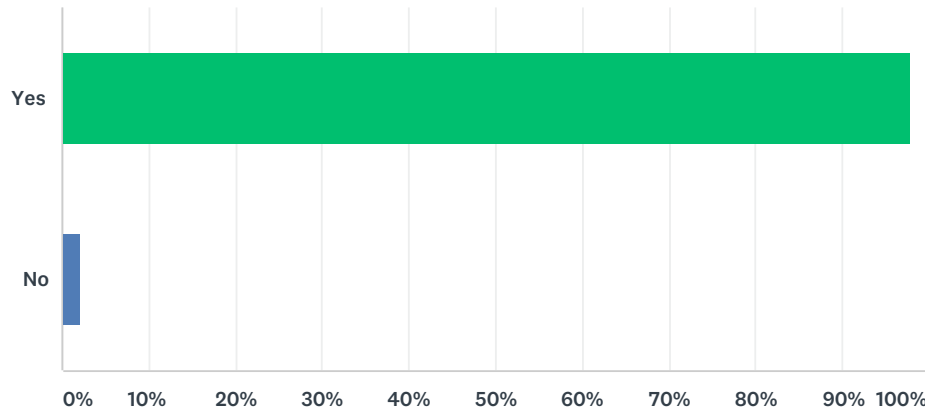

Q17 Do you intend to practice law after you graduate from law school?

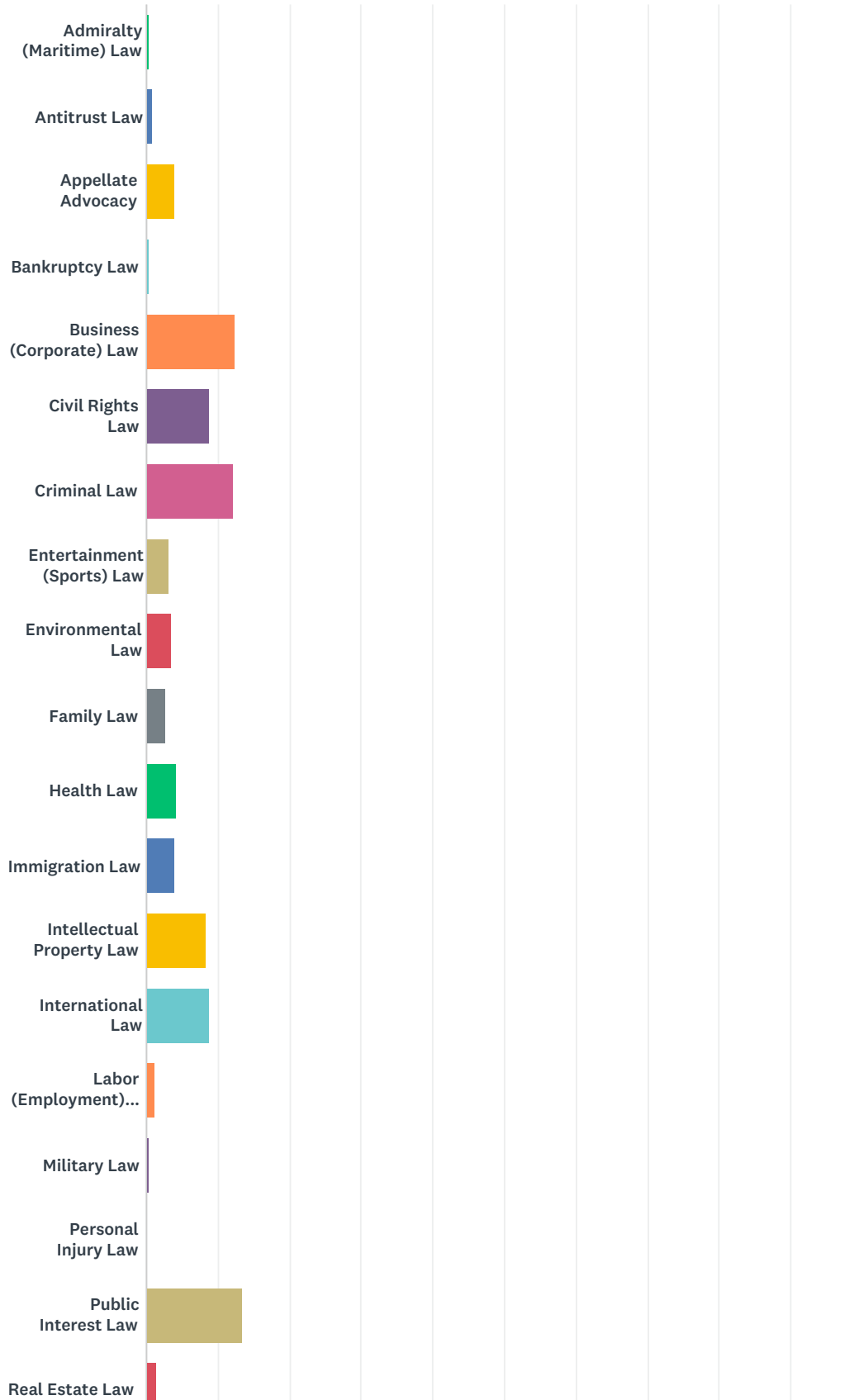

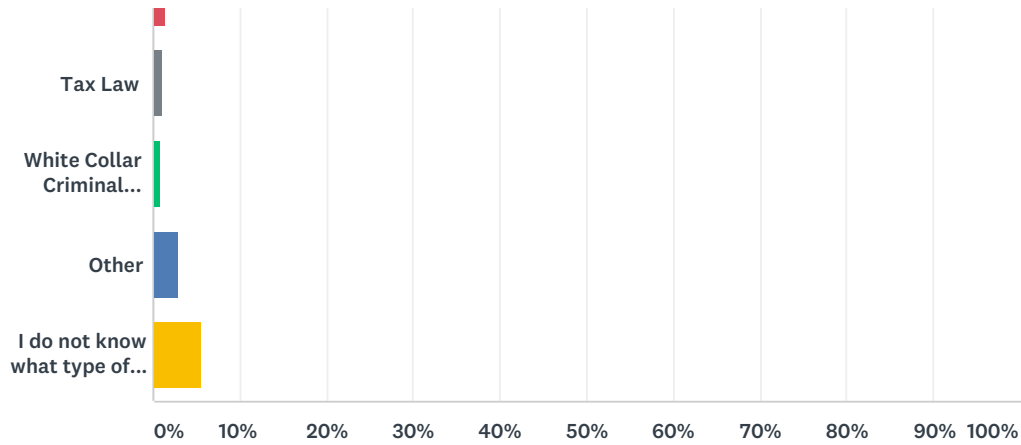

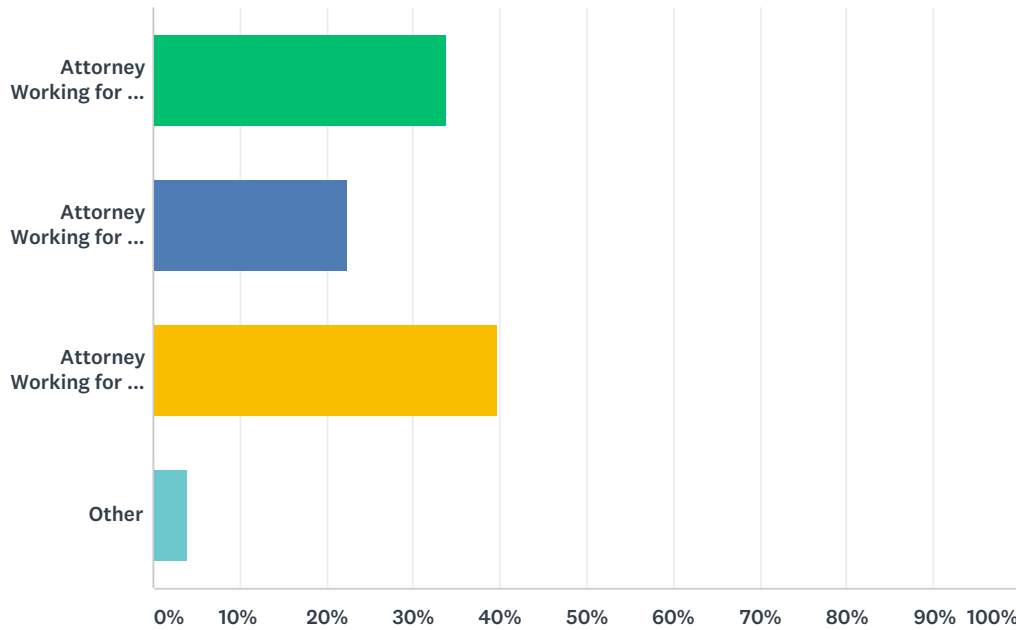
